Reading

This week we will continue our first unit in Reading: You + Me = Special. Our unit question is What Makes Us Special. Our skill this week in reading is predicting. This week we will continue reading Franny and Ginny and Daddy, Could I Have an Elephant?

Social Studies

This week in social studies we will continue Unit 1: A Community of People. Students will continue learning about a community. They will also recognize the responsibilities of citizens to the community.

Saxon Phonics

This week we will be working on lessons 6-10 in Saxon Phonics. Our lessons will include: The Rule v, Blends, Spelling with k and c, Syllable Division: vc/cv Pattern and on Friday we will have our assessment.



Science

This week in science we will be studying lessons 3-5.

Lesson 3: Identifying human-made and natural objects.

Lesson 4: Sorting objects by the material from which they are made.

Lesson 5: Solids, liquids, and gases.

English

This past week we reviewed organizational skills and journal writing. This week in English your child will continue to learn about synonyms and antonyms. Synonyms are words that have similar, or almost the same, meanings. Antonyms are words that have opposite meanings. We will also work on capitalization and punctuation rules.

This week the word they need to know is stroll. The definition of stroll is to walk unhurriedly. The synonym is walk and the antonym is run. Example: My grandparents stroll through the park every afternoon.

We will review for their skills test Ch. 2 on Thurs. and test on Friday.

Saxon Math

This week we will be working on lessons 6-10 in Saxon Math. Our lessons will include:
